**Subject:** Supply and Delivery of One Fire Apparatus Rescue Truck  
Tender PWE 18-31 Results

## Recommendation:

THAT the purchase, supply and delivery of one fire apparatus rescue truck be awarded to the tender bid submission received from Carrier Centers Emergency Vehicles in the amount of \$310,758.00 (excluding HST).

## Purpose:

To inform Council regarding the supply and delivery of one fire apparatus rescue truck tender PWE 18-31 results.

## Background:

In accordance with the corporate Procurement of Goods and Services Policy No.: GG-4.16, dated October 16, 2013, tender PWE 18-31 was publically tendered utilizing Biddingo.com; an online portal that connects suppliers providing various goods and services to buyers from the Provincial, Municipal, Education, Crown Corporation, Housing, Construction and Healthcare sectors and Private companies from across Canada.

Following the submission of bids on Tuesday, July 3, 2018, a public tender like opening was held in which three (3) bid submission was announced.

## Analysis:

### Supply and Delivery of One Fire Apparatus Rescue Truck

Fort Garry Fire Trucks	\$308,836.00

Subsequent to the tender opening the submitted bids were reviewed Fire Services who confirmed that the tender bid submissions from Dependable Emergency Vehicles and



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Fort Garry Fire Trucks failed to meet all of the Municipality's required vehicle specifications.

### **Financial Implications:**

Fleet Services and Fire Services Department Administration Staff has reviewed the tender bid submission for compliance with the respective tender requirements. The tender bid submission received from Carrier Centers Emergency Vehicles for the purchase, supply and delivery of one (1) fire apparatus rescue truck in the amount of \$310,758.00 (excluding HST) is recommended by staff for award.

Fire Services Administration Staff in consultation with Fleet Services c/o the Public Works & Engineering Department budgeted \$350,000.00 in the 2018 Capital Budget.
