Dear Council,

I was involved in a single motorbike accident of my own accord just south of the Try Recycling Inc Entrance, on Clarke Road on August 30th, 2018. I am emailing you in regards to the middlesex center invoice of \$1,594.72 that I received in the mail.

On that day, my wisdom teeth which I have had removed in October were causing me pain and dizziness. It went unnoticed until I wore my full face helmet for a period of time. While I was riding down the road I incurred a sudden spell of drowsiness, and I went down on my 2009 Kawasaki Ninja 250 in the bend in the road. As I was going the speed limit I did not incur many serious injuries, but at the time I went down there were bystanders who witnessed my accident, and called emergency services. As I waited for the ambulance my partner who was riding his own bike pulled my bike off the road as to not impede traffic. A fire department volunteer had made his way to the scene before anyone else had arrived and informed my partner that paramedics and fire were on there way. He then told him he believed it was radioed as a collision between an suv and my bike, he tried to radio out to let them know it was a single vehicle accident but said that his radio could only receive not transmit. After a brief amount of time the Ambulance arrived and took me to victoria hospital. Before anyone else had arrived on scene I was already gone.

I would like to talk in person about this invoice and come to an arrangement with middlesex centre for the hope that the amount could be reduced, as I am not able to afford the \$1,594.72 as a full time university student.
