Subject: 2019 Concrete Replacement Program Tender PWE 19-05 Results

Recommendation:

THAT the 2019 Concrete Replacement Program be awarded to the lowest tender bid submission received from Autoform Contracting London Ltd. in the amount of \$111,820.75 (excluding HST); and

FURTHER THAT the Mayor and Clerk be authorized to execute the necessary documents.

Purpose:

The Municipality of Middlesex Centre requested complete tenders from qualified bidders to provide all required labour, equipment, materials, permits/approvals and provisions for traffic control, covered by the Ontario Traffic Manual, Book 7, and temporary conditions, necessary for the replacement of approximately 1,810 metre length of existing substandard concrete sidewalk infrastructure in the Municipality.

Various locations throughout the settlement community of Delaware containing such substandard sidewalk infrastructure to be replaced under this year's program are included in Appendix A.

Background:

As identified by Department Administration Staff in our annual sidewalk inspection, a significant portion of the Municipality's existing sidewalk infrastructure is of a deteriorated condition beyond repair and/or of substandard width, requiring replacement. In accordance with the Corporate Procurement of Goods and Services Policy No.: GG -4.16, dated October 16, 2013, form of tender PWE 19-05 was publically tendered utilizing Biddingo.com; an online portal that connects suppliers providing various goods and services to buyers from the Provincial, Municipal, Education, Crown Corporation, Housing, Construction and Healthcare sectors and Private companies from across Canada.

Following the submission of bids on Thursday, March 14, 2019, a public tender opening was held in which the following four (4) bid submissions were announced.

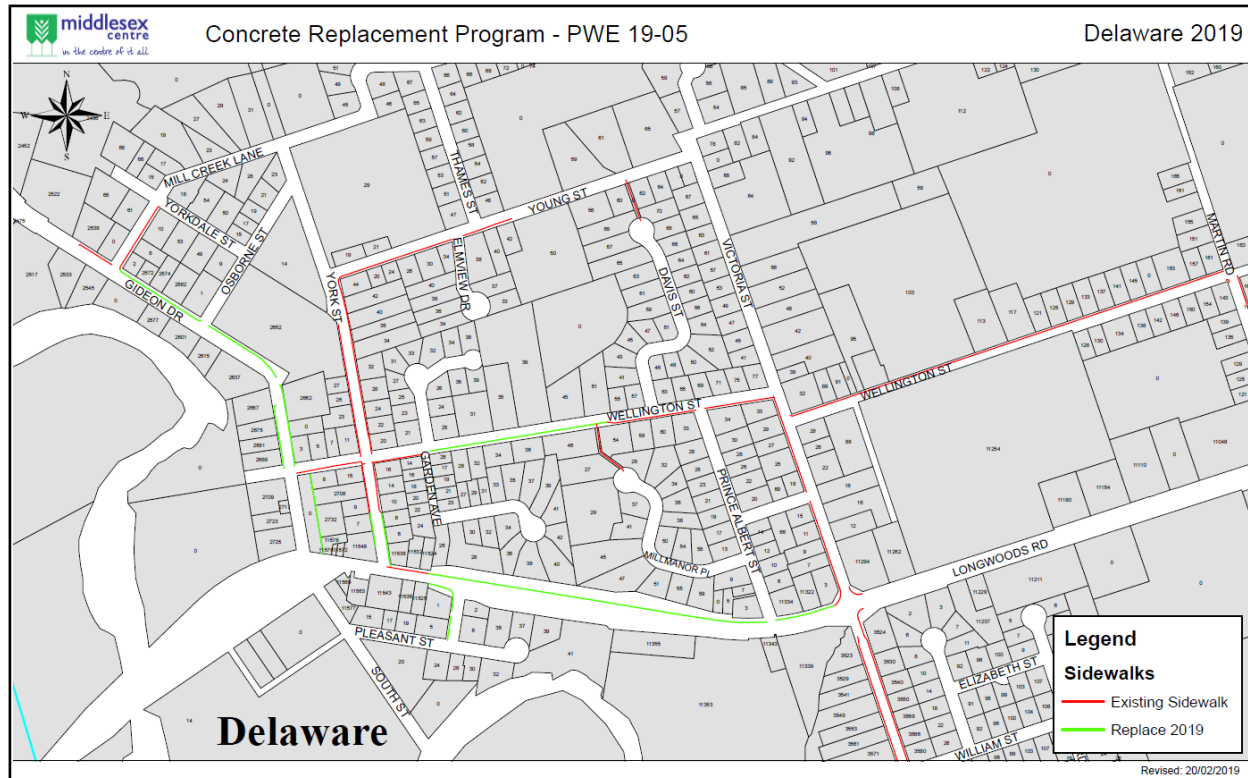
Financial Implications:

Public Works and Engineering Department Administration Staff has reviewed each tender bid submission for compliance with the respective tender requirements. The lowest tender bid submission received from Autoform Contracting London Ltd. for the 2019 Concrete Replacement Program in the amount of \$111,820.75 (excluding HST) has been accepted. Public Works and Engineering Administration Staff had budgeted \$150,000.00 in the approved 2019 Capital Budget. The balance of approved budget funds will be utilized in this year's program to replace additional sub -standard sidewalk sections throughout the Municipality as determined by Administration Staff.

Strategic Plan:

Middlesex Centres 2012 - 2017 Strategic Plan, identifies one of its strategic themes as Quality of Life, "residents want to enjoy peaceful, well -kept neighbourhoods and efficiently delivered services. Middlesex Centre must continually look for and take advantage of opportunities to both maintain and to improve the quality of life for all residents." In addition, one of the common themes that repeatedly emerged during the resident consultation process of the Strategic Plan was the desire for residents to maintain connectivity within their own community.
