Subject: Tender Results – Watson Municipal Drain Construction Award

Recommendation:

THAT the construction of the Watson Municipal Drain Extension be awarded to the lowest tender bid submission received from Robinson Farm Drainage Ltd. in the amount of \$230,669.16 (including HST).

Purpose:

To obtain Council approval of the tender award with regards to proceeding with drainage works under Section 4 of the Ontario Drainage Act.

Background:

A Petition was submitted to Middlesex Centre to request an Extension of the Municipal Drain.

The drain services Lots 18 and 19 of Concession 13 and Lot 19 of Concession 12 in the former Lobo Township as well as Lots 22 and 23 of Concession 1 in the Municipality of North Middlesex.

Report number PWE-036-16 was approved by Council on September 21, 2016 to proceed with the requested drainage works. By-law #2018-075 was passed, enacting the Engineer's Report for the drain design and cost estimate. The project proceeded to the tendering stage with one bid being submitted.

Analysis:

The following tender results were received and listed as follows:

Contractor	Bid Price (Including Tax)
Robinson Farm Drainage Ltd.	\$230,669.16

Financial Implications:

GM BluePlan Engineering staff have reviewed the tender bid for compliance with the respective tender requirements, and the lowest tender bid submission received from Robinson Farm Drainage Ltd. has been recommended to be awarded. The cost estimate provided by GM BluePlan Engineering for construction was \$200,744.50 (Including HST). Of that \$29,924.66 that was tendered above the estimate, approximately half (\$15,255.00) is part of Item A.4.2 (Temporary Support System for Regional Watermain) and will be assessed directly to the Regional Water Supply.
